Membership application

Standard membership in The Swedish Association of Graduate Engineers requires a Master of Science or a Bachelor of Science degree in Engineering, (minimum 180 credits). A Master of Science or a Bachelor of Science degree in Technology is also accepted as a qualification for membership. Membership is also open to students of technology who have completed at least 165 credits towards a Master of Science in Engineering, and to other university graduates with a Bachelor level degree in another technical or natural science discipline or higher.

Student Membership is open to all students studying for a degree with a designated major in the above disciplines. As soon as The Swedish Association of Graduate Engineers receives confirmation that a degree has been awarded, Student Membership is automatically updated to a Standard Membership.

Method of payment

For Standard Membership, payment can easily be made monthly by direct debit from a bank account. Fill in the full account number, including the bank's clearing number, in the space provided

Conditions for payment by direct debit (Autogiro) – authorization

I hereby authorize The Swedish Association of Graduate Engineers, corporate identity number 802003-4586, to use the automatic payment service Autogiro to deduct my membership fee from the account I have indicated. The bank is not responsible for checking authorization or for notifying me in advance about each payment. Withdrawals will be noted on my bank statements. This authorization can be transferred to another account at the same or another bank if I so request.

I will ensure that there are sufficient funds in my account no later than one banking day before payment is due. I authorize the bank to transfer payment in accordance with the bank's rules for such transactions.

Payment may be made from my account on the due date or up to one week thereafter on condition that The Swedish Association of Graduate Engineers notifies me in advance of the amount, payment date and method of payment. This notification must occur the first time a payment is made and then in conjunction with any changes in the amount.

I understand that the bank must approve the use of my account for Autogiro payments, and that the bank and The Swedish Association of Graduate Engineers have the right to terminate my access to Autogiro.

Bankgirocentralen, BGC, manages the Autogiro process on behalf of the bank. I therefore give permission for information regarding my account number and account address to be registered and integrated with BGC's information.

This authorization is valid until further notice. It will terminate at the end of the calendar month in which I notify The Swedish Association of Graduate Engineers of cancellation. Alternatively, I can stop one or more transfers by contacting the bank no later than two banking days before payment is due.

How to complete the AEA membership application

Personal details.

Write your name, personal ID number and current address.

1. Application for

Specify if the application is for membership or if you are transferring from a different unemployment insurance fund. If you have worked abroad, specify whether you are currently working in Sweden or if you are unemployed. Contact AEA Utland (Abroad) for further information.

2. Work conditions.

Are you or have you been employed? Specify which employer you work for or have worked for. Confirm your employment with a certificate. You can for instance provide a copy of a pay slip, a statement of income or a certificate of employment. **(NB. Not a contract of employment.)** Are you self employed? Specify the name of your company and corporate identification number. As self employed, you confirm your employment by signing the application form.

3. Signature.

For the application to be valid, you must date and sign the form.

Conditions for membership

To become a member, you must fulfil both the work requirement and the academic requirement. Membership is granted at the earliest from the first day of the month AEA receives your application. Membership cannot be granted retroactively.

Work requirement for membership

The work requirement is fulfilled if you work or have worked at some point.

Transfer

You may only be a member of one unemployment insurance fund at a time. If you transfer your membership you are entitled to include your former membership period on condition that the transfer is made without interruption to the membership period. You should therefore send your application immediately after leaving your former unemployment insurance fund.

Membership fee

For your membership to be valid, you must pay the membership fee.

Academic requirement

You fulfil the academic requirement if you are or have been a member of a SACO association, Vårdförbundet or AEA. As a member of Sveriges Ingenjörer you fulfil the academic requirement.

What is required in order to receive benefits if you become unemployed?

To be entitled to unemployment benefits should you become unemployed, you must

- **Be registered as unemployed**
- **Have worked long enough in order to fulfil the work requirement**
- **Have been a member long enough in order to fulfil the membership requirement**
